



Program Name: “Christianity and Slavery: Lessons from a Checkered History”

Program Description:

Christianity proclaims freedom for captives. Yet centuries ago, slave traders twisted it to support the brutal trans-Atlantic slave trade. In “Christianity and Slavery: Lessons from a Checkered History,” Moody Radio’s Julie Roys honestly explores this dark chapter in church history. She takes listeners inside an African slave castle where so-called “Christian” slave traders herded Africans before shipping them to Europe, the Caribbean and the Americas. But, Julie also tells the other side of the story – how in the 1800s, Christians championed abolition and changed entire societies. This documentary features interviews and natural sound Julie captured while visiting the Elmina Slave Castle in Ghana, West Africa. It also includes interviews with leading evangelical scholars and historians, as well as two roundtable discussions. The first roundtable features members of an African-American church, who also visited the Elmina Slave Castle, and share their profound and emotional experience. The second roundtable gathers African-American and white Christian leaders to discuss how believers can move beyond the legacy of slavery and toward a more God-honoring future.
